The Burning Heart

2024 is well underway! Already late April when writing this! Among other things, that means it is time for the Emmaus Community to be considering prayerfully people we could/should sponsor for this year's Emmaus walks.

This is one of the beautiful agape tasks we have in Emmaus - to be the human source of seeking someone to be blessed with "a walk to

Emmaus." Those first disciples heard directly from the mouth of the risen Jesus a vivid explanation of the Old Testament scriptures, revealing Himself in the books of Moses & all the prophets - the result being that their hearts "burned within them!"

Just what must that emotional time have been like? It included seeing Jesus as Messiah in all the 39 OT books. This must have been ecstatic, exciting, enlightening - a blown-out-of-their-minds experience - to say the least! This should be ours also in 2024 - as we search the scriptures & find the Saviour of sinners in every book!

Many New Testament exhortations point the Christian to a mature Christian life but one of the best - if not the best - is Heb. 12: 2ff where we read "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the Author & Perfector of our faith..."

The verse continues to elaborate on this by focusing our attention on Christ's suffering on the cross, His joy in doing so & His ascension to the right hand of the throne of God.

I commend this truth to you for your daily advance into your 4th Day - to remember that the Father's love for you motivated Him to send His Son into this fallen world, endure the penalty for all our transgressions - then He rose victoriously from death, ascended to His Father where He now rules with all authority this world's directions.

Such is the peace & assurance of the child of God! I believe in this Jesus!

It is such an exciting but busy time as the team formation comes together. I am now preparing for orientation and finalising the talk and prayer partner allocations.


